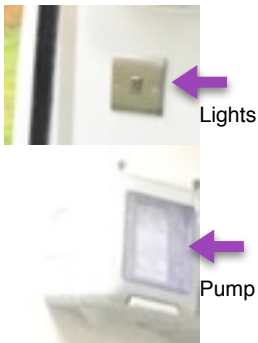




So how do I plug in my van?



1. Firstly you can turn the lights and the water pump on (which is situated in the rear) by the two switches inside the loadspace. The interior lights are powered by the switch right next to the side door and the white switch next to the table powers the water pump. These are both 12v and run off your vehicle battery so will always work even when your not plugged in. It is important to turn these off in between grooms and your water pump switch is fitted with a buzzer to remind you to turn it off. After arriving at your destination turn both of these switches on and get your long cable that we supply, ready to plug your van in.



2. Simply take the long cable and walk to the rear drivers side of your van. There you will see a black square cover. Lift the black flap up on the van socket. Next find the blue plug end of your cable and lift up the blue flap on the plug. As you slide the plug over the inset socket the flap on the blue plug will slide in and clip onto an interior edge inside the socket to stop the plug from being pulled out. This connection is waterproof. IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT TO UNCLIP THE FLAP BEFORE YOU PULL THE PLUG OUT OTHERWISE YOU CAN RISK DAMAGING THE CONNECTION AND VOID THE WARRANTY.



3. Now take the cable and walk to your customers electric supply. Plug in the 3 pin plug end into the socket and turn the socket on. This connection is not waterproof and needs to be kept inside.

Your van is now Live and Ready to Rock!



Important!

Don't forget to unplug the van and stow the cable away before you drive off as your customer wont appreciate you driving off with their house still attached to you!
